Camp Algona POW Museum, Algona, Iowa

This was the site of a prisoner of war camp that housed more than 10,000 German prisoners from 1946 to 1953.



The Algona Nativity Scene was built by Eduard Kaib, Horst Wendlandt, Eric Knoll and three friends who were Prisoners of War at Camp Algona. When the war ended, they donated the scene, which includes 65 one-half life size figures, to the town of Algona.

The Nativity Scene is now under the care of the First United Methodist Church of Algona & located at the Kossuth County Fairgrounds
